



Home free from PFC? Yes, please!

Privacy policy of oaisfair.com

Pursuant to Art. 13 Sec. 1 and Sec. 2 of Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), hereinafter referred to as: GDPR, please be advised that:

1. The Personal Data Controller is fabb Sp. z o.o. Al. Armii Krajowej 178, 43-300 Bielsko-Biała, registered in the District Court in Bielsko-Biała, 8th Commercial Division of the National Court Register at No. KRS 0000668648, VAT Reg. No. 9372691985, REGON Statistical Id. No.: 366806136, BDO 000055654, share capital of PLN 4,000,000, hereinafter referred to as the „PDC”.
2. Your personal data shall be protected and processed for correspondence and handling the case it refers to and in order to file claims and defend against such claims, if any – the legal basis shall be the legitimate interest of PDC pursuant to Art. 6 Sec. 1 letter f of GDPR – i.e. handling cases submitted via form, correspondence with entities concerned and the cases submitted by such entities.
3. Your personal data shall be stored for the time that is necessary to fulfil the purpose with a regular control of their usefulness evaluation. The period of personal data storage may each time be extended by the limitation period for claims if personal data has to be processed in order for the PDC to seek any claims or defend against such claims.
4. You provide your personal data voluntarily.
5. Your data shall be processed based on the agreement concluded or actions requested by you before conclusion of the agreement (GDPR Art. 6 Sec. 1 letter b), in order to:
 - a. carry out the sale/purchase process and will be stored for the period preceding conclusion and during performance of the agreement;
 - b. handle appeals, complaints and applications and will be stored for the period of 3 years of closing the case.
6. Your data may be processed based on legitimate interests of the Controller (GDPR Art. 6 Sec. 1 letter f), in order to:
 - a. carry out the sale/purchase process and ensure proper level of services and shall be anonymised once the final product is developed;
 - b. carry out audit and inspection activities and will be stored for the period of 5 years of completion of the activities;
 - c. determine and seek any claims or defend against any claims and shall be stored for the duration of the proceedings or the limitation period for claims;
 - d. collect and seize claims and shall be stored for the period of 10 years from the end of the calendar year of making the payment.
7. Your data may be processed in connection with fulfilment of the obligations imposed by the Controller (GDPR Art. 6 Sec. 1 letter c), for the purpose and to the extent for fulfilment of the obligations arising out of tax and accounting regulations.

8. Your personal data may be provided to:
 - a. the provider of services of accounting, invoicing, settlement of agreements, service quality assessment, debt collection, legal advice, and analysis;
 - b. providers of IT systems and services;
 - c. postal operators and couriers;
 - d. authorities statutorily authorised to receive your data.
9. You are entitled to have access to data and request correction of the date, deletion, limitation of their processing, to transfer the data and to object against data processing, as well as to withdraw your consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent prior to such withdrawal.
10. You are entitled to file a complaint to the President of the Office for the Protection of Personal Data if you find that your personal data are processed in violation of the regulations of GDPR. 11. Your personal data shall not be subject to profiling.
12. The provision of your personal data is voluntary and failure to provide the personal data required by fabb Sp. z o.o. shall result in refusal to perform the subject matter of the agreement.
13. Information on cookie files:
 - a. The Website uses cookie files.
 - b. Cookie files (so called „cookies”) are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored on the user’s device and are intended to enable the use of websites. Cookies usually contain the name the website where they come from, time of their storage on the device and a unique number.
 - c. The Service operator or co-operating entities are the entities inserting the cookie files to the Service User’s terminal equipment and having access to those files.
 - d. Cookie files are used for: creating statistics that help understand how Service Users use websites, which helps to improve their structure and content.
 - e. Two main types of cookie files are used within the Website: „session cookies” and „persistent cookies”. Session cookies are temporary files, which are stored on the user’s device until the user logs out, leaves the website or closes the software (browser). Persistent cookie files are stored on the user’s device for a fixed period set in the cookies` parameters or until they are deleted by the user.
 - f. In many cases, web browsing software (browser) permits storage of cookies on the user’s terminal device by default. Service Users may change the settings in that scope. Web Browser allows removing cookie files. Automatic blocking of the cookie files is possible. Detailed information can be found in the web browser’s help or documentation.
 - g. Restricting the use of cookies may affect some of the website’s functionalities.
